


Student Supply List—Grade 7

The following is a list of what each student needs to bring to class on the first day of school.

Please be sure that your child's name is on all supplies & uniform pieces.

- ☐ 2 binders (preferably with zipper, different colours)
- ☐ Duotang folders - 1 Yellow (Math), 1 Green (Science), 1 Orange (Health), 1 Blue (English), 1 Red (Social)
- ☐ Yellow for Math, Green for Science, Orange for Health, Red for Social, blue for English
- ☐ 2 packages of subject dividers for binders
- ☐ 1 pair of headphones
- ☐ 8 Hilroy scribblers or exercise books 8 ½" x 11", no coil rings (2 blue, 1 green (LA), 2 yellow & 3 of either pink or gray for LA/Discipleship)
- ☐ 600+ sheets of lined loose leaf paper
- ☐ 1 package graph paper
- ☐ 2 boxes of Kleenex (bring to class)
- ☐ 1 package of thin markers

- ☐ Coloured marking pens (2 colours of choice—these will be used extensively)

- ☐ 1 Dictionary & Thesaurus
